Accurate X/Y ITM or GPS co-ordinates	ITM co-ordinates are usually found on your Ordnance Survey Location Map in the top right corner. GPS co-ordinates provide your location in latitude and longitude and appear as two numerical values, such as (51.877520, -8.507442).
