



Top Tips for Creating Your Poster



Pick one Stay Safe, Stay Clear safety tip for your poster and try not to use any other writing.



It's important to know what message you want to show in your poster. This needs to be really clear so everyone can see it.



Think about who your poster is for. Winning posters will be part of a calendar going to every Primary School in the country so think about what other children would like to see on it.



Use one large picture or just a few small pictures to show what your Stay Safe, Stay Clear safety tip means. Too many little pictures will make it confusing!



Think about what you are drawing. We are telling others about how to be safe with electricity when outside playing so a picture of someone in space might not be the best way to show this!



Colour is really important for your poster. Sometimes just a few colours works better than using every felt tip or crayon in the set.
