

# **Utility telephone numbers are changing**

Here's what you need to know

This year, non-geographic numbers (NGN) such as phone numbers starting with 1850, 1890 or 076, will be replaced by 1800 or 0818 numbers in Ireland as a result of a decision by the Commission for Communications Regulator, ComReg, to address preceived consumer confusion and high costs of using NGNs.

Since December 2019, calls to NGNs cost no more than calls to landline numbers but the next step is that phone numbers in the 1850, 1890, and 076 ranges will be withdrawn from use in Ireland on 1st January 2022.

In 2021, all 1850 Gas Networks Ireland, Irish Water and ESB Networks telephone numbers will be replaced by 1800 or 0818 numbers in line with ComReg requirements.

1800 numbers are free for the caller whereas 0818 numbers cost the same as a national landline call.

#### **New numbers**

In most cases the 1850 prefix has simply been replaced with 1800 or 0818.

However, Gas Networks Ireland's Customer Care and Carbon Monoxide Information Line phone numbers are changing completely (as the 1800 equivalents are already in use by other organisations).

Gas Networks Ireland's Customer Care Line will change from 1850 200 694 to **1800 464 464** and the Carbon Monoxide Information Line will change from 1850 79 79 79 to **1800 89 89 89**.

All of Gas Networks Ireland's new 1800 and 0818 numbers are now live and can be used in place of the 1850 numbers.

Both the old 1850 and new 1800 and 0818 numbers will operate in parallel for the remainder of 2021.

All 1850 numbers, with the exception of the 24hr Gas Emergency number and Dial Before You Dig number, will cease operation at the end of 2021.

#### **New numbers**

In most cases the 1850 prefix has simply been replaced with 1800 or 0818.

All of Irish Water's new 1800 and 0818 numbers are now live and can be used in place of the 1850 numbers.

Both the 1850 and 1800/0818 numbers will operate in parallel for the remainder of 2021.

All 1850 numbers with the exception of Water Supply Queries and Water Supply Emergencies will cease operations at the end of 2021.

#### **New numbers**

In all cases the 1850 prefix has simply been replaced with 1800.

All of ESB Networks new 1800 numbers are now live and can be used in place of the 1850 numbers.

Both the 1850 and 1800 version of the emergency number will operate in parallel for the remainder of the year.

The 1850 variants of some others numbers are now routed to a closed information message. All 1850 numbers with the exception of the emergency number will be ceased at the end of 2021.
